**Facts about incumbent Mark AMODEI:** BA UNR; law degree McGeorge School of Law Attorney—U.S. Army (JAG) Corps from 1983-1987 —President of Nevada Mining Association 2007-2008 (while in the Nevada Senate)—. Nevada State Legislature, 1996-2010; U.S. Congress 2011-present—Divorced twice, two daughters—

- Liberty Score 43% conservative (43% Conservative Review; 54% from Heritage; 58% from Club for Growth – a solid F)
- In 2014, Amodei voted to continue funding Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program. DACA was the precursor to Obama's executive amnesty "But his [Amodei's] no vote comes as a

surprise because, in an interview with the Sun on Thursday, he said he would vote for the bill to end the president's program.” (Las Vegas Sun)

- Amodei during his 2011 campaign stated he “would never raise Obama’s debt limit.” (Huffington Post)
- In 2013, that was exactly what he did. Amodei voted in favor of the 2014 “cromnibus” bill. Amodei is using his position on the powerful Appropriations Committee to push his own personal agenda noting, “You can send out messages very clearly so everyone knows what’s expected.” (Las Vegas Sun) To that end, Amodei frequently meets with top federal officials. He has successfully included language pressuring federal agencies to consider holding conferences in some of Nevada’s largest cities. (Las Vegas Sun) In 2018 he voted to increase the debt by \$1.5 Trillion.
- Ardent supporter of the Stop Online Piracy Act (SOPA), which sends the government farther into the private marketplace and the Internet. (Heritage Action) Amodei is a co-sponsor of the so-called “Marketplace Fairness Act,” that would expand sales tax collections to online transactions.

- Amodei voted to expand collective bargaining rights (Las Vegas Sun)
- Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid, D-Nev., has called Amodei “hilarious” and fun to be around.“ He’s likeable, he’s easy to work with, and he doesn’t take himself too seriously,” said Rep. Jim Moran, a liberal Democrat from northern Virginia who serves on the House Appropriations Committee with Amodei. <http://www.rgj.com/story/news/politics/2014/08/09/amodei-uses-humor-help-make-mark-congress/13850487/>
- Carson City Judge James Todd Russell co-owns a piece of property with Mark Amodei, ...did not disclose his financial relationship with Amodei, who at the time was the chairman of the GOP, which was the plaintiff in the suit before the judge. What’s more, 10 days before the May 19 hearing,... Amodei had announced his candidacy. The GOP had sued the secretary of state, who had called for a free-for-all election, which would have greatly diminished Amodei’s chances.
